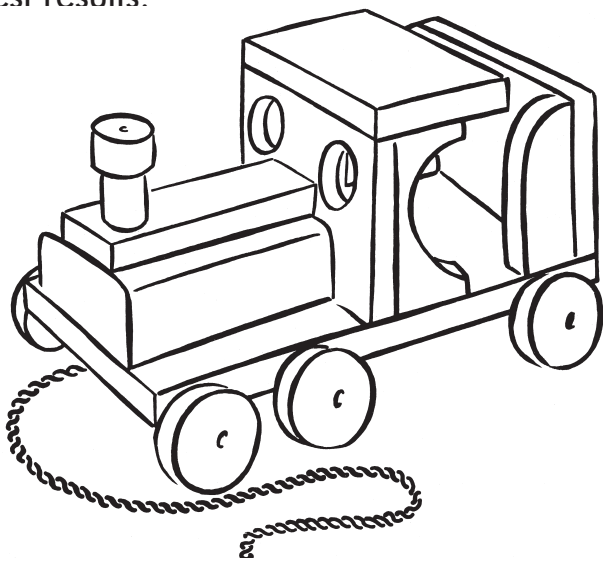


HOW TO

MAKE A TOY TRAIN

Your child will spend hours playing with this toy train. We recommend you paint the train in a very colourful and creative manner. High gloss premium paint will give you the best results.



TOOLS

- Hand saw or jig saw
- Drill and hole saw
- 180 grit sandpaper

MATERIALS

- Pine 140mm x 305mm x 90mm
- Pine 90mm x about 1.5m x 19mm
- Pine 42mm x 600mm x 19mm
- PVA wood glue
- 30mm tech screws and
- 1 x 60mm for smoke stack.
- Washers 1cm with 3mm hole

SAFETY

- Always keep tools and materials away from children.
- Read the instructions before beginning your project.
- Wear an approved dust mask when cutting, planing or sanding timber AS/N251716.

WHERE TO BEGIN

1. Cut 140x19mm pine to length 305mm
2. Cut 90mmx19mm into 6 blocks 140mm long.
3. Cut one of the 6 blocks length ways into three pieces, each at 19mm x 30mm to be used as axles. Screw or nail and glue to base block (see Fig 1).
4. With 35mm diam. hole saw cut out circles as indicated. Save circle cut out for smoke stack (see Fig 2).
5. Cut 42mm x 19mm into 4 lengths, 90mm long (see Fig 3).
6. With two of these use 60mm hole saw and cut windows (see Fig 4).
7. Round off other 2 pieces as shown.
8. With 60mm hole saw cut 6 wheels from 90mm x 19mm pine.
9. Assemble all components as shown in complete picture using PVA wood glue and nails or techscrews. Pre-drill all techscrew holes. Place washers on each side of wooden wheels.
10. Paint in bright premium colours.

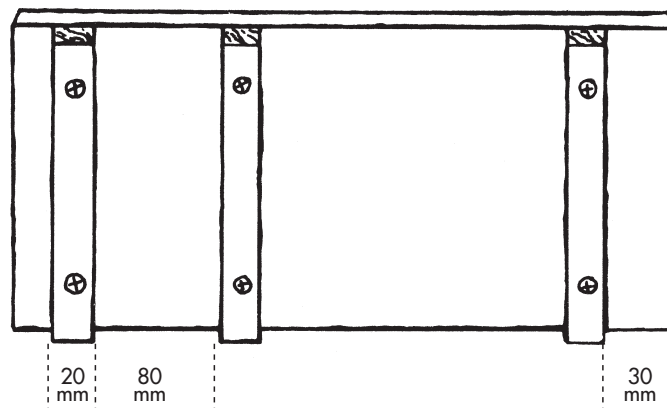

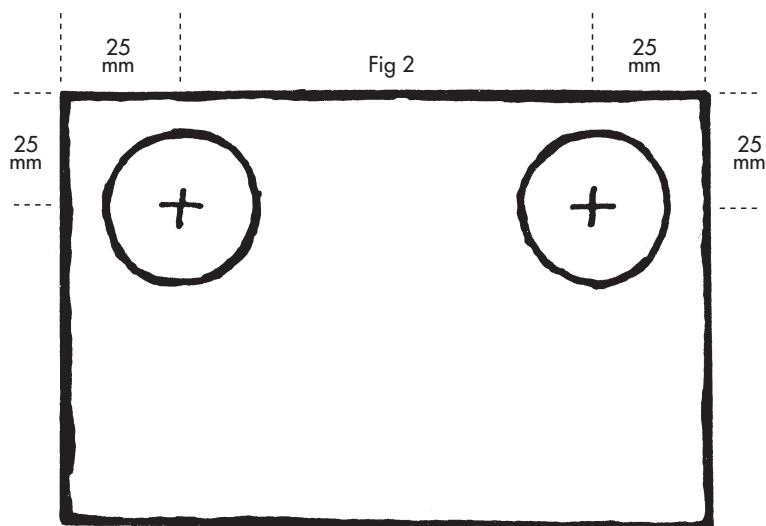
